Do you feel you know what the organisational structure of the Centre is? If not, what is unclear?

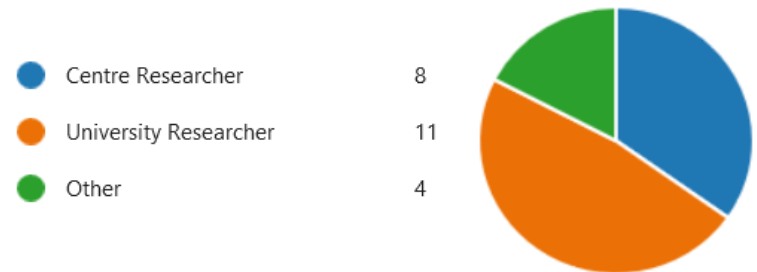

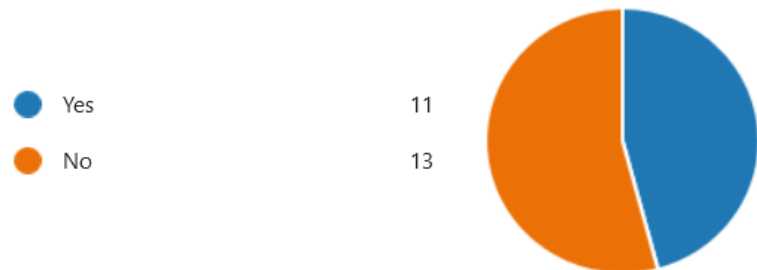
What do you wish you had been told when joining the Centre?

Do you think of yourself as a Centre researcher, or a university researcher?

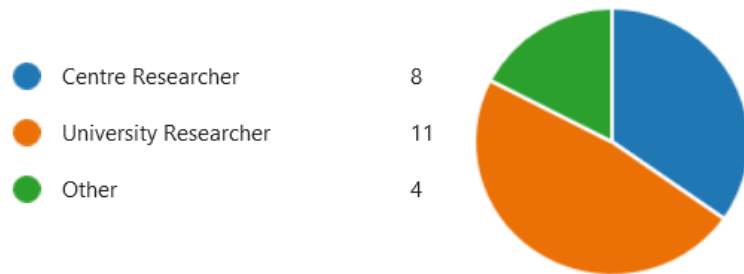


Are you currently collaborating in a substantial way with a researcher at another node of the Centre?

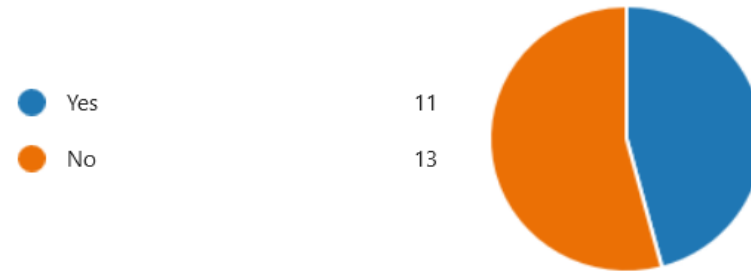
