

SGM & SUPL Induction Programs



- SUPL Induction required by anyone who will work in SUPL.
- SUPL inductees required to be First Aid qualified.



- SGM Induction required by anyone attending SUPL >5 days per year.
- SGM inductees required to be First Aid qualified.
- SGM inductees required to attend site at least every 6 months.
